One day he asked the woman, "Did God really say you must not eat the fruit from any of the trees in the garden?"* <sup>2</sup> *"Of course we may eat fruit from the trees in the garden," the woman replied.* <sup>3</sup> *"It's only the fruit from the tree in the middle of the garden that we are not allowed to eat.
